Regional Transportation Plan (RTP)**

The following provides the Overarching Goal and the Policy and Process Goals as stated in the TVCP Policy Group (PG) Partnering Agreement plus the proposed TVCP Implementation Goals and Objectives that will serve as the basis of the TVCP Evaluation Framework. The Evaluation Framework is the primary tool that the PMT and TAC will use to help develop and select the multimodal transportation solution packages for the TVCP.

To develop the Evaluation Framework, the TVCP Project Management Team (PMT) has coordinated with the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC), with consideration of guidance and input from the Community Advisory Committee (CAC) and the public. The PMT is working with the TAC to refine the Measures (both quantitative and qualitative indicators) to apply to the framework as decision making input to the Policy Group (PG).

The plan should reflect community needs and desires for the corridor to evolve into a thriving, welcoming place that connects our vibrant growing community now and for future generations.
